named coach or uh Lewis Orr shout out to him r IP to him He was the head coach at Bowling Green when I when I was there and the whole recruiting process and you know he was there every step of the way I always say like that was the reason probably why I picked Bowling Green because a lot of a lot of schools was contacting me but I was in talks with the assistant coaches Yeah the scouts and you know things like that it wasn't the head coach This was like one of the ones where it was the head coach coming to my door you know in the morning before high from my high school you know picking up the newspaper to get to me like just little stuff like that It was like pay attention to listen like little stuff like that I'm like all right So if the head coach really want me I feel like that's where I should go So ended up going to BG you know did my thing there for four years Um Yeah moved moved out here on that results Let me backtrack a little bit So then we left Bowling Green and went to Canada went up there you know we just wanted to play pro you know that's just like that's everybody's dream is to play as long as you can So went up to Canada you know did my thing up there for a year and then it came out here uh coming out here in L A was really just a like it it wasn't like I wasn't thinking I was gonna move out here and just you know seven years six years later I'm still here It was more or less Let's go out there let's train go to the Drew League you know try to build up this basketball you know a little resume in L A and then shoot we might go out to Canada you know I go back to Canada That was kind of the whole mindset but fast forward Six years we're here We still so what was the what was the experience like in Canada Like what was the reason why you didn't keep uh playing in Canada Yeah it it was it was cool you know it was a it was a dope experience I feel like everybody that's in the basketball even football space Just that sports aspect is you always try it you always you know go play as long as you can And so it was a great experience and like I said the plan was to go back but you know coming out here you getting your you know getting into different other things you know positive things but you know getting into things where it's just like all right do I wanna go back there for five months and then try to start this back over again Like it was a hard decision like it wasn't that it was just so super easy to try to figure out but I think I made the right decision Got you So you leave Canada you get to L A What was the process like of just you know getting adjusted to being out here and like you know playing your season and like getting adjusted and grounded to like the L A life Oh It it was tough Like I don't wanna make it seem like it was just everything peaches and cream It was it was it was pretty tough But I

think I got a strong strong mindset you know I always feel like you know I'm gonna make it happen one way or another That was always my you know my my my thought process with everything I do So you know coming out here trying to figure it out trying to you know what what we gonna do man you gotta make money That was kind of the thing was like all right So I'm gonna go out here and train but you know I still gotta pay my bills I still gotta figure this out So I end up getting a job with the uh with the NBA So it's it's a company they call Second Spectrum They're the official tracking company of the NBA So they all them crazy stats you see on ESPN according to Second spectrum lebron James is 35% driven It's like just those I care about People are just paying to like each little detail detail stuff like that but they was hiring So I'm like all right Well let me get in here It's a little part time job You know I can make a little money while I'm out here Still trying to figure it out Fast forward later This this company has got huge like like bigger than I could ever imagine for real Like I think when I first started it was probably like 20 employees before I before I knew it They had about 100 Yeah like you've been there for the build up build up Yeah So I'm like all right So I mean I was part time they didn't just ask me to work full time So all right I'm I'm in L A now like this I'm still doing what I love as far as basketball So that was kind of what got me like I would say like grounded and got me to the point where I'm like all right I think L A might be the home like for the time being Got you So you were saying um you wanted to play in the Drew league Did you get the opportunity to do So how was that Like cause you know the Drew League they got how the way they how the way they promoted it it's like you know lebron could pull up one day Kobe James Harden Anybody could pull up but like the atmosphere go crazy though So like how was it like getting into like the Drew League or like what's like is it like a certain type of requirement You gotta have to be in there and get accepted Like how was that Yeah I think it it do But so so for me it was it was more or less like I I know I I see the people that's been played and ex excluding the big time NBA guys like the you know other guys that's playing there like I didn't played against a lot of them like that that that's really where I felt like I belong but people don't know me So what I had to do was just hit up anybody I can when I first got out here I think I was hitting up Uh like I don't know if you ever heard of Freddie Barnes BG I hit him up cause I knew he was out here in L A So I hit him up I'm like hey bro like I know you're a football guy but you know any any basketball leagues anything going on he he hit me up immediately

Like hey I got somebody you know in this league in Venice like this is random league So I pull up pull I show I knew I had to show out I knew I had to my first two weeks in attitude the first impression the best impression So I like I go out there I get a dunk They stopped the game get the recording and I'm like you was you was filling yourself after the game Sure enough I'm walking out a dude on the other team walk up to me like hey bro you got you playing you playing a Drew this year I'm like that's just what I need to hear Like I don't know nobody I don't know nothing about it I don't know how to get in there He like man you you gonna be on my squad That was that was all it took I got crazy like that So it was dope it was dope So when you got in the Drew how was that experience of finally you know playing in there or like did you play against any like you know high end names or high end guys I played against Nick Young played against um It was a it was a couple couple good good players I can't remember off the top of my head but they they were good and the experience was actually different Like I ain't gonna lie the team that I played for in my very first year Like these were guys that was born and raised in L A like like they believe the Drew League So like I didn't know that So I'm going in just thinking it's a regular you know just a Drew League cool little game Like they really they crying like they this is this is this is my life Like y'all ain't gonna like I'm like oh shoot All right So I it it was a cool experience to be on that team But like if I could do it all over again I would try to get on a team that like you know can really let me you know ball out and not so much just be like that L A brand team but all in all though It was it was it was super dope to be a part of the So is do people get like paid to to play in the drill league Is it just like ST like recreational It's more recreational but it's just like it's it's good for your brand you know like nowadays it's so important to have your own brand and you know to to kinda build off that So being in front of all those cameras you know Nike is sponsoring you get free all these different things that's free So like it's more or less just getting you out there to you know do whatever you want to do for the future For real But you ain't it there's no like payment for anything So you think that's bigger than getting paid So would you ever think about going back or Yeah yeah for sure For sure If I get the right team I I plan on playing this upcoming season the next summer I plan on playing for you have like your own team or you gonna join some other team I join some I mean best case scenario Get some dude from the Midwest cause I always say like you know II I think the Midwest got the best hoopers man If you ask me say that Shout out to my L A Yeah like but no L A got some Hoopers like you got you got what James Harden Kawhi They got Westbrook they got all them but they that it I'm like you got Midwest You talk about Detroit Chicago Illinois Indiana And he is the one of the biggest saying you got people from like you said Steph Curry lebron Derrick Rose from from there Draymond ad like that's what I'm saying It's some we got some bangers man So that would be the I mean in the best case scenario I do I could hope we love to get a team from the Midwest bring them out here to the Drew League and I think we can mess around and win it No I don't think they got the difference between us and now I think they got that grit factor for real Right Right No iii I can see that I can see that Yeah cause it ain't nothing else to do out here You got Hollywood you got all the extra beaches and sunshine you know Don't get me wrong It's like it's it's the gritty out here I've seen it But overall man I I love to have the Midwest team out here but we'll see we'll see hopefully in the future we can have that happen Got you So you left uh you got you played one year in the Drew League and then you said you went to Spectrum Yeah Yeah I went to Second Spectrum That was I mean I was working Second Spectrum This is this is a summer thing It was just a summer a couple few months I got But yeah so did that for four years Did that for four years work the Second Spectrum Uh like I said it gave me that foundation that I really needed I really wanted you know being out here and then that's when I got the call for winning time winning time was about to ask that you got into entertainment or TV How did you get into that That's pretty much like time I would say is kind of the the kickstart for you know wanting to get into entertainment and content creating and all that stuff So with that was actually uh you know another crazy story So a guy that I work with Uh his name is Noel Shout out to Noel He uh he's a football guy actually he played at San Jose State Uh I think he got like a training cam deal with the Raiders or something like that But real you know real football guy Uh but he worked in SEC a second special with me in the football department and he was also the double for um Spencer James all American So that's what he was doing on on top of all of Second spectrum So he just got this email We was sitting at work he got this email about some basketball show Hold up You said he was a devil So that means he like the stunt man or something like that the stunt double because one of them some of them routes he was running and uh in the show I was like I probably well no he was getting better as the show went on So that probably was that was probably bro all they probably yeah they probably gotta get it was it was bad at first though I gotta I gotta watch it I tell you it's one it's one clip He tried to run a curl ride It was the worst ride I ever seen in my life I said no I'm like you could tell this Hollywood it girl for real But yeah that that's stuff like that is is actually super fun to see now that you're in the entertainment world a little bit But but yeah so we sitting at work and he like uh hey bro I got this email from you know my reps the same people that got me the all American job It's some basketball show coming out like a no hooper man You you pull up to this show I mean you pull up to this tryout I'm like all right So mind you I just pulled my hamstring like the day before two days before something like that Like bad to the point where I can't even I can't barely walk when you pull a hamstring It hurt it hurt to sit down it hurt to get up It's bad Like me there's I'm like there's no way they're not going to this tryout There's no I don't even know what this is at this time I don't know what the what the what the show is with the I don't know what it is I just know it's a basketball show that's coming out No way I'm missing this tryout or audition That's what they call audition But you try So I I pull up it's about 50 people in there We all they all just getting one single foul line You know we all gonna just go one at a time You like what I want y'all to do is I want y'all to sprint up and down the court with the ball sprint up and sprint up back lay up jump shot and that's it And so it's about 30 seconds long Now that's all that's all we want from you My turn to go I take off running Can't can't do nothing bro I'm I'm going like this up and down the court looking crazy in front of everybody Like I'm like it's a wrap So I go over to the casting director guy Shout out to Adon I'm like hey man I tried I know I pulled my hamstring a couple of days ago you know I I gave it all I can He looked at me and was like before you even walked into this gym I was already gonna pick you you good just hit up that hamstring and I'll see you in two weeks I know that you know before before that I didn't know him before that So I don't know if they they was you know check the facts you know check the the IG I don't know I really don't know But I I guess I just looked apart So yeah so fast forward that that was before COVID though So we filmed a film in episode one of season one of winning time Um COVID hit when after COVID came back after COVID ended or whatever somewhat ended we started filming the rest of season one and I've been on it for season one and season two that comes on HBO Max HBO Max I just I just started watching that Like when I got out here That's crazy Like I just finished it Good show isn't that That's what the Lakers Lakers the eighties Lakers Yeah Yeah So for season one I was probably about 12 different guys Yeah All throughout the season I had a they put a beard on me sometimes I had a like it was it was super cool But then for season two

they they made me strictly a double same stunt double for one of the main guys norm Nixon So I took all his basketball stuff for season two So that was it it was super dope I wish we could have got a season three You know they didn't they didn't bring it back for season three It was a good that was getting good It was crazy Season two man It was it was an amazing experience and I say that's what that's what really got me into this entertainment world So I wasn't working with like you know all them actors and stuff that that's some uh big time actors in that show bro Wiw Harris brody like uh Jason Segel uh John C Riley like all these guys I'm right here We we right here with Wood Harris like we super cool So like the point that the fact that I was able to like get in that close and have these conversations with them it's like all right like shout out to basketball you know basketball got me in the door but we're about to go all in Um it it ain't no reason why So we still we're still in the beginning stages But did he give you any like tips or like you know recommendations or anything Adrian brody I'll never forget he he super super you know established actor One thing that he told me was don't take anything personal and I feel like the more you you know get into these different avenues and different opportunities coming and going Like that's something that you gotta you know keep in mind It's like if something don't go your way it's not personal man It's just business it just keep it going If it if it if it didn't happen it's just not for you but what's for you gonna come and that'd be so that's so hard to think of not to think of for sure It is It is because you always think like why did he pick me Is it It was it was this if you just look at that part like uh some somebody else told me I can't remember exactly who told me this but they were just like you know they won't hire Denzel Washington for you know the Batman role or you know different like it ain't it ain't nothing to do with different people It's not for you Like it's a job for you So that's something I'll I'll keep in mind all the time Got you So what are you looking forward to or what do you have planned to like coming up now that uh you finish uh winning time Yeah So I mean I I'm you're into you're into we can you can do that you into content creating like IG so that you pretty got AAA big pretty following So how does that uh how did you get into that So it so it was kind of a kind of a a long thing because me and my brother we kinda started together where we was like let's let's create content but you know we don't wanna do the the you know the corny skits and the different things like that I ain't really what we was into but I love to create like I was one of them dudes as a kid you know creating players on Madden creating I knew that to this day still I love that bro So like

getting older getting you know seeing the the different ways to monetize it and still be my basketball lane I feel like it was really a no brainer being out here in L A meeting different people Shout out to Chris Staples That's another guy that you know helped me along the way made it feel like it was you know I actually can do something out of it So just being around the right People I feel like that's one of the most important things you know having people to motivate you to do what you really wanna do and do what you love basket Like I said basketball is what I love So being able to be in the production size and monetize what I love and not have to be in the NBA I think is a blessing So you said you monetize from it How do you uh monetize Do you get like a check from like Instagram tiktok or So you get so mostly youtube is where I didn't know you put uh stuff on youtube So I'm on youtube I'm on all of them guys youtube Instagram tiktok Facebook Facebook pay everybody pay you for that bag and youtube is So yeah I do the reaction videos on there It's just more just creating man I just you know I I love to create and you know still stay in my basketball lane So it's kind of what it is So how did you I see you do like uh commercials now something like that How did you get into that So commercials that's kind of that whole just like you know being like winning time kinda started it off But yeah just being in that Lane Network and you know meeting the right people I've people that I've worked with on winning time Um It's people that I've worked with in commercials like that whole basketball entertainment world is real small Like it's not that big it's not that very broad Yeah it's not it's not that broad So if you're in there you kinda you kinda it's kinda kinda good So yeah just just talking networking you know being in the right place at the right time I think that's the most important too Being out here in L A is super important So so where do you see yourself um going forward with this Like what do you got planned or like what are you trying to do for like just with um with basketball and the entertainment side Yeah I wanna keep going as long as I can Like I always say like I want I'm gonna be jumping as long as as long as I can So for instance like Bradley Bill I just work with him I was his stunt double for a commercial you know because the NBA guys they I don't know if they don't want to or if they can't but it's something to where you know they they're not really gonna be doing no dunking in in commercials Like that's not really what they wanna do if they get hurt in the commercial That's all that So it's always gonna be you know uh room opportunities for that So yeah I've worked I've been his stunt double I've been Scoot Henderson stunt double I've been Russell Westbrook Stun like all

these guys that's that's getting paid a lot of money to be in these commercials You know they got all these different opportunities for the for people like me to be a part of it So I I wanna do that as long as I can And then also I wanna give other people opportunities like I feel like I was put on this earth to you know help people you know I always say like I live a blessed life so if I can help other people that live a blessed life as well like that that's what I'm here for So yeah like the connections that I've built within the commercials and you know TV shows and stuff like the up and coming people that can't make it to the NBA or you know don't go overseas don't wanna go to Europe to go play basketball They can still make a good living over here Yeah I was just gonna ask that you know a lot of people from you know the US if they don't make it into the league they go overseas to hoop for a good good amount of time You didn't have you didn't think to do that or you didn't want to It's like it's not that I didn't want to because I had the opportunity I had you know a couple offers to go to Iceland go to these different these different places and who knows man like who knows if I would have just took that you know the small contract and you know did my thing there then moved to Paris and you know kept moving up which I've had teammates you know that that has done that So it's like I don't regret it I mean I always say like what if what if I would have been like you know what like I'm going overseas like I don't care about nothing else Like I don't care about coming to L A I'm going overseas I I could have did that but I think I made the right decision but you know everybody everybody got their own journey Got you got you So ah you don't gotta go into full detail How much would you say you made off a winning time or just like commercials or stuff like that Is it a good is it a great pay Good pay Yes it's it's pretty good I it's yeah it's it's paying the bills for sure We know that we know that it's paying the bills money but it's just it it kinda just depends you know on what your role is because there's there's extras in in commercials there's extras in TV shows and then there's actually do I guess it's tiers you know extras doubles main cast like producers Like it's it's different tiers So it's all about what tier you in for that specific you know specific thing So for commercials like if you can get it's called OCP uh on camera principle like that them are the roles that I feel like everybody strive for like extra extra work is great Don't get me wrong cause you can network and you know build up for the next thing But what you really wanna do to really you know change your life is to do the OCPs which means you on the camera they can see your face on the camera and then that's when you get residuals and all those different things for the

commercial So that's that's where that's where it all pay off at So yeah do you wanna um would you are you trying to would you say you were trying to work towards like being like a main role or like a TV TV show or TV I would love to I would love to like like they got like the Drew like the Drew like something like that Yeah like I I would love to man like and I'll be lying if I said like I wanted to move to L A and be an actor like like that I would I wouldn't my mindset at all It was it was basketball That's thing got me in the door of doing that So I will say no no Like I said like I was saying earlier like getting in the door meeting wood Harris and meeting all these different guys and seeing that it really is possible Mike EPPS dude Hilarious Like I couldn't stop laughing He was playing Richard Pryor and winning Yeah So just being around these dudes and like they're regular people Like I'm like not not if they could do it I could do it but it's just like all right it's possible you know it's it's real possible So Yeah definitely man So yeah I'm gonna take acting classes do all those things and go all in with it Yeah One day one day y'all gonna see me doing a nine BB which is gonna be crazy because like you were saying earlier like getting out your comfort zone like I'm mostly a shy person like I I grew up real quiet like so people even people from back home like you acting like what Like it's crazy crazy but I see it you know I see like more comfortable with myself you know got more to talk about So yeah I'm gonna go I'm definitely gonna try to get a all like a real good good role and even if it's not basketball I mean it is what it is got you you said you uh felt like you was put on this earth to help people You say that's uh something that you was trying to do in the future you know what to what extent Like what were you what did you have in like mine Yeah So one thing I I really wanna do I've been working towards it is it's starting a nonprofit like start a nonprofit to where we travel the world travel the country Like that's something tutored I love is traveling So if I could kill you know two birds with one stone you know help people all travel the country you know go to different schools do backpack giveaways toy drives all these different things to help out you know the younger generation because I feel like that's what we need Like definitely not as a kid Like I there's certain people that I remember to this day like adults that came in and you know like who is that Like you know so I wanna be that that same person to the kids and let them know like you don't gotta make it to the NBA You know you don't gotta be a rapper like it's it's so many different ways that you could still be super successful So that that's the goal you know down the road do uh charity games you know back to back in the midwest different just different things

like that do different positive things for the youth man Cause I just feel like that's what it's all about the future Yeah I definitely agree with you Um We're just the same I feel like the same with me Um I had started my uh first annual youth uh football camp uh this past spring that I did but that was only because like you know I wanted to give back to the community And like like you said I just wanna show everybody like you know you don't gotta be like a rapper you don't gotta sell drugs you ain't gotta be a double boy None of that If you can play football get to me or even you know just go and be great in school and like have like a trade or something that you can do that But I definitely I definitely wanted to uh I definitely wanna continue to do that as far as like um having like a a profit or a nonprofit organization and just like charity and like give back because I know I'm definitely doing my youth camp again But this time I wanted to incorporate where it'd be like a lot a back to school like backpack giveaway or like maybe it's like a cleat giveaway or something like that So I definitely yeah I definitely wanted to do that and a part of that like it with my with me having my degree in sport uh management I also had like a business plan where I always wanted to um open up and own my indoor sports facility complex But you get like I know I was going I was talking to like some some people that was like have you ever thought about making like a nonprofit organization So it's good ways you can you can get into that for sure So yeah if you know somebody like try to link me because I I've been I've been yeah that's real I got them I got the vision is just you know putting it out there is I'm kinda like all right Where where do I go from here and you know it's hard to trust people here and there So you know if you got somebody good for me let me know No definitely I got I got you for sure for sure I got a little trivia question for you So you're Hooper you said you're a hooper So we gonna see you probably will get in I see some questions though So who is the all time leader in assist The all time leader in assist is John Stockton That's correct John Stockton by a lot too I wouldn't think that only reason why I mean not the only reason why he was a great passer but he played for like 20 years I think magic would have got it if he would have played longer than 1213 years getting like probably like Steve Nash should have or like Jason Kidd or something like that A kid like yeah No they probably like top five Yeah all of them was top five That's why I was like it's crazy No John Stockton was probably probably 70% of them was the Carl Malone That's crazy Uh Who is the all time leader in rebounds all time leader in rebounds That's tough man All time leader in rebounds Mm Give me a you know a conference It is Uh it's a Western

Western conference Wait wait Yeah Western western conference Yeah Dang that's tough You just tell me dude rebounder It ain't I I couldn't go I couldn't go points Everybody knows I tell their point I couldn't go points I gotta go I gotta go different categories It's crazy cause I really I feel like I have looked at this recently man It ain't it ain't well it ain't kin I'm gonna give you 333 tries man Mm I'm gonna be mad when you tell me you're gonna be mad I'm gonna be so mad What to start with WW dang Who is it Wilt Chamberlain Will you said it ain't will You said it ain't will You said it You said it ain't will it a ka I'm like oh he just threw it off the list I'm like I ain't supposed to be like I mean I I was gonna let you go I was gonna let you rock gang I you feel me All right All right All right Who is the all time leader in steels all time leader in steels all time leader in steals Yeah that's tough It's tough Yeah see if you like Gary Payton Nah it's a good guess though That's a good guess That's a good guess It's not GP all time I did surprise me when I when I had saw it too I ain't gonna lie It surprised me It gotta be somebody that played for a while Um It's gonna surprise you for sure It's gonna surprise you What conference we the Western conference I don't know the all time leaders It's crazy and nobody would think it ain't Stockton It's just a stock it's crazy I was like he got I'm like he the all time leader and still that's crazy That's what I'm saying I'm like I'm like ain't never nobody ever talked to him Him being no no lockdown defender I thought he was a liability That's what I'm saying I'm just going off of ESPN man Uh who is the all time leader in blocks the all time leader in blocks Hm Conference Uh What what team do you play for Western Probably play for a few It's a Western all time leader in blocks Yeah Mm mm Who's out there Just throwing stuff Mm There's a couple of big men in the west that that went that went crazy I went crazy It was out in a crazy amount of blocks It's a good it's a good time Is it Kareem Nah not Kareem Mm mm That's a good guess though Yeah I'm gonna just try to name some people but that's a good guess though Uh somebody cause it gotta be somebody that had a long career cause that's how they be racking them up David Robinson Nah What that Spurs spurs and the Spurs and 01 more And then I you might got me on the blocks I think I got you I think you got me I got you Is it Ken Oh OK You got it You got it for sure I didn't think you was gonna get it I thought you I thought you was gonna say Shaq or somebody or like man I thought you were gonna say like man B or somebody I didn't know we on the second we got to start bench or cut somebody We got Wendy Chet and I couldn't find I couldn't find nobody else So I said deandre Jordan I was like deandre

Jordan All right Well DeAndre Jordan is definitely getting cut cut too out of those two I mean deandre a great player but I think Chet and Wim is generational players honestly So it's a bench one We gonna bench Why you why you better be careful what you say here I know you're gonna get a lot of you're gonna get a lot of a lot of controversy if you get All right That's all right I'm gonna have to bench I'm gonna bench Chet which is tough because I like Chet I like chat a lot Like I think a lot of people sleep on him because they they love Wendy so much But wen be different though Wendy I think we be gonna be he gonna be one of them all time leaders in something I don't know what it's gonna be but he put if he put weight on it I think he definitely can get get to get to that level for sure So yeah we're gonna we're gonna start wi wi be he like we've never really seen nobody like him like that height with that that ability and skill set It it it's different but I mean I don't think nobody's ever been that tall and not been injured So he gonna have to make sure you know he take his body as best as possible which I think he will But being that tall you know I was gonna say it's it's all types of factors I hear now like in the game like that's why cats like lebron James Tom Brady they didn't like you feel me They didn't take care of their body for so long So they got they got that type of technology where they can pay for it Now they say yeah he paid like a million dollars You spend a million dollars in your body like but not I think about for him it's not as it's not as bad because he he's a billionaire so a million a million is not nothing to him Yeah But I get I get it though Yeah it's crazy It's just investing that much into you mean Yeah it's just your body like but that's what that what makes him get get his money and really you think I say you really think about it You feel me he invest in that but he getting it right back So I say Tom Brady I said yeah Tom Brady is doing the same for real Well he was he was doing the same yeah he was doing the same crazy thing about I mean Tom Brady was the same way but it's like brown is literally the oldest player in the league Like it's not even like he like the sixth oldest seven he's old and he averaging what He's averaging like it's crazy like KG and Kobe and all them guys and they was like that old they was averaging like 12 points 13 points not doing with Bron I wasn't uh I I'm not gonna lie I might get controversy for this I was not a Bron fan I was I was gonna say I wasn't a Bron fan I liked that Bron but I wasn't as big on him like everybody was for real and it's only cause like yeah he was going crazy He was doing like stuff like nobody ever seen of but that young but like he used to cry a lot to me bro And I like I be like you that I'm like you too big to be crying like you might as well just you feel me you

know it's gonna come with it He might as well just be tough but at this point you know he he didn't got the all time scoring record man He like you said he's the oldest player and still averaging 30 30 30 10 and 10 Some crazy crazy like yeah like like you said like I'm from Ohio like literally from from the same state as this guy But I'm a Kobe dude Like that's a war up bro Like it's one am I'm supposed to be asleep I'm still on the west coast trying to watch the Lakers play like I was die hard Kobe Like I always say Kobe the reason I play basketball Kobe the only reason why I wanted to move to L A too like that big big on Kobe So because of that I couldn't be that big of a lebron guy So I think I became a big big lebron or bigger lebron fan once he came to L A because it was all like that Ohio to L A fan So I don't think I don't think people give Kobe is uh uh a much the respect he deserved for like being in like the goat category which is crazy to me bro Like I always say he might go I think Jordan is the go I think I think that too And I only say that because like when you think about people like when I think of goats for real for real I think of like people who who like actually like started like the wave or like the what's the trend or like you feel me for people to like look up to So I feel like I feel like Kobe lebron or like everybody was like looking up to Jordan like you feel me like that's who they aspire to be Like trying to be as great or not if greater than him So that's the only reason I put him as there for for but to to a certain extent some people didn't they say like you didn't see Jordan play That is a good that's a good argument to have So that's true That's why I'd be like I mean I I ca I can't call him my go then he probably the go but he Kobe is the greatest I ever seen Like I I think Brown got the longevity goat like as far as just being great for so long like consistently great But as far as like the best at like at one point in time like that 81 point Kobe like that whole time like I ain't never seen no no basketball player better than that You think who who's the best athlete the best athlete Bron Bron there as far as the best athlete ever He he he gotta be up there Oh so oh not including basketball You know we talking about basketball football boxing Bo Jackson Bo Jackson He's somebody like cause I I like on youtube I do the reaction videos So I people will be requesting me to do different players So I always heard of Bo Jackson you know but I never really watched him So looking at those videos like him or Dion Dion might be up there too you know being able to play all those different sports like and be good at a multiple sports I think it's crazy for real I would have to Bo Jackson is crazy A lot of people don't know he was he was like real life like crazy for I think he like messed up his Yeah Yeah he he was so he broke his

hip Yeah he's like well the play that he broke his hip or whatever like he put so much force into the ground that his body wasn't able to absorb it like he got hit or something instead of just falling He yeah he he didn't he got hit and he could have went out of bounds but he kept trying to go But like he was so strong that it literally his body couldn't absorb it That's crazy And I was about to say if he had if he got to if he was healthy actually probably would have been one of the greatest if not So who you say is the greatest athlete ever Uh That's a hard one I would say either I got a top three It would probably be Dion I gotta go Bron just because it's like I said it's the longevity that counts like everybody want everybody dreams to play for the long for that one Yeah because like it's a lot of people that's playing it that's been in the league a long time but they don't do nothing Like I just saw a stat with PJ Tucker literally got 0.12 straight games is crazy You literally getting paid millions to just be out there But I literally I think it's I go Dion Ron and probably Floyd Floyd Yeah I probably go Floyd cause he he definitely the the the best boxer of all time I I would say so Yeah and I only say this because I only say that because he never lost And then what I like about Floyd cause I'm a big I'm a big boxing fan too What I like about Floyd is like the you know how it's always controversy and matches about um he should he lost this or he should have won that He always went back and fought that that person again and beat him again just to show like all right yeah I'm gonna show y'all why I won the first time you know so I I say Floyd for real for real and it's just like the whole aura about himself Like he's uh he got confidence but he works for it He worked for it So it's like you know all that you feel me the best ever The money team all of that It's like people people don't know like when they see the videos of him like he's actually working out like two big workouts a day and 3 a.m. in the morning He ain't sleep be out there grinding And that's why I'm like you feel when you put in that work you can't you can't really you can't really doubt nobody or like down somebody for being confident or being happy about what they put in work for and like how they they said they can't do that So yeah that's that's why I'm like he actually put the work in So I I say yeah between them three it probably be Dion Brown or uh Floyd Yeah So that's a good three right there I had another speaking of Brian you got this star being Scott This is the last one you got Brian KD Orian start So we talking about prime right now and they all in their prime all of them from their pro Yeah I feel like this is a good one man I got a bunch of lebron super big So I don't know I know you got Bri KD and yanni this is the this is a big thing right here So we go we go

yeah that's tough Yeah we gonna when this go viral I just want my I just want my uh I want my uh what's that My credit you know it's a good one It's a good one It's tough because for one Giannis his his accolades his awards Like he pretty much got everything you could think of He got MVP finals MVP Defensive player of the year Most improved Like he got everything you could think of if you go look at his his accolades But I'm gonna have to I'm gonna have to cut cut Giannis just because it's it's there's no other option You gotta cut Yannis It's tough It's tough because like any given game he could go for 4010 and 10 but he ain't better than KD or or Ron in their primes So who you who cutting who I'm cutting who you you just said you cutting you said I'm benching Oh man Mm I'm a bench bra man just because because when both of them played against each other when they call it K two and oh I mean don't get me wrong He went to the 73 and nine He went to the team He was down 31 against all that all that But KD different bro Like KD different So yeah I got I gotta go KD man Money sniper for the win Ok I'm a KD fan too I I rock with it Yeah People going people gonna hate you they gonna hate you for that But I just remember vividly him just pulling up in Brian's mitt you know in those spins matchups No Yeah Play I remember in the matchup I think he punt fake and Brian fell and he drove to the land I said I said he got it I'm like he got it got it He got it All right There's one more This last one It was it was um who was it Wait did it delete Well I think I remember I think it was Karim K it was Kareem Wilt and Shaq Kareem Will and Shaq Laker Laker Bigs Ah dang man You making these so tough man You making me so tough Hey man um specialize in putting pressure on people I see what I do All right All in their proms We gonna go Yeah I think we got Kare That's tough Like Shaq probably is known as the most dominant big in his prom in his prime Wilt had 100 in one game which he probably wasn't going against He was going to probably one against a bunch of Bill walls You know how that goes If it wasn't for Bron Kareem would be the all time leading scorer So it's tough So who we gonna cut ah we're gonna cut Wilt Oh we're gonna cut wilt That's it's tough I know he averaged 5025 for a for a season which is crazy but we're gonna cut wilt just because he was losing a lot of finals They were playing against Boston He I don't think he had that good of a of a finals record and I don't know how true it is Y'all correct me but I heard that he kinda like he was great in the regular season but when playoffs came he he wouldn't show up like he was supposed to like he knew in the regular season So I I don't know how true that is but y'all let me know So we're gonna cut we're gonna cut will

Then we gonna bench we're gonna bench Kareem We're gonna bench Kaine bench Kareem which is which is tough but we gotta start Shaq my boy Kobe three rings help help get Kobe three rings If Kobe went on that team he wouldn't he wouldn't have won the rings but Kobe needed him too So Kobe we gonna we gonna start Shaq Kobe three rings got you All right We go we almost done We're gonna switch to another topic real quick and I don't want you to get in trouble but I don't wanna get in trouble I know your lady is here You just wanna know like what's the what's the like one thing you look for in like your in your lady or your significant other You should say one thing or it could be a few matter Um Don't say nothing She ain't got cause you gonna get in trouble You get in trouble later Don't do that I told him I warned him I warned him but no I I would say she gotta have something going for herself Like she can't be someone that's just sitting there you know not doing nothing Like you don't got no ambition ambition Like like I mean you ain't gotta be busy all day every day but you gotta you gotta have some type of some type of passion for something you know I gotta because I could that's how I am Like I need you to be able to do what you're doing when I'm doing what I'm doing and we come back together you join forces at the end of the day I don't wanna just you just sitting around just waiting you know ain't doing nothing and you feel like I'm too busy you know this and that So I think she gotta have something going for herself you know And uh yeah I think that's that's the biggest thing Got you got you what um would you say to somebody in your shoes Maybe like if maybe like you say you know you graduated from you graduated college now you're trying to figure out the next lane and like basketball or like entertainment what would be your advice to to that one that make it be younger or you know I would say make sure you network like is that sound so cliche you know network you know go to these you know different different events different things like that but it's important like like that one conversation you know could change your life even if it's a even if it's somebody that you don't you know that they say something that you don't like like you could take that with you and you know use that for your life So I would say networking is probably one of the biggest things and you know just just chase the passion chase what you love Like eventually you will you will figure it out But like I feel like a lot of people kinda like settle for things they don't really love to do they don't really like to do and I don't think it's enough money in the world for that honestly So you know just just chase your passion chase what you love to do you know be be that that positive life for other people and you know just
